- Mid Year Report
 - We began the year with \$41,495.09. End of December cash balance is \$76,454.73.
 \$44,329.11 raised from fundraising initiatives. In total our receipts year to date equaled \$49,303.11. We have spent \$14,343.47, resulting in a surplus of \$34,959.64 year to date.

Approval of Nominating Committee
