- CTPTSA filed our 1099 NEC form by the January 31st deadline.
  - Form 1099 NEC is a compensation document that reports money paid to a
    person who is not an employee of \$600 or more. For 2023 fiscal year, the only
    vendor we paid over \$600 was Dave Leu from Leujam Entertainment (brings the
    inflatables for the Summer Send Off).
- Proposed Budget Updates Approval Needed
  - 5th Grade Signs
    - ✓ Reduce budgeted income to \$503 (which is the amount we took in last year (late Paypal sweep) since we won't be selling signs this year.
  - Den Dash Fundraiser
    - ✓ Add \$700 to budgeted income for additional corporate matching funds that have come in since January
  - General Donations
    - ✓ increase income line item by \$100 because we received a \$100 donation in March that put us \$20 over budget.
  - Gift-a-Book
    - ✓ increase budgeted income by \$50 because we are \$25 over what we expected to have donated this year.
